

## **SCHOOL OF CONNECTIONS**

### **CBI 101 - Fresh Start in Life**

**6 hours**

This weekend seminar is now also available in a class format on Sunday mornings! Fresh Start will help you understand how you can take the steps to fulfill Jesus' purpose for your life. The class will orient you as to how we help you do that here at WBCC. The class is a prerequisite to church membership.

### **CBI 102 - Becoming an FDFX**

**6 hours**

Scripture tells us that God is changing those who love Him into the likeness of His Son. What an adventure! Come learn about five stages of Christian maturity and our role in becoming "Fully Devoted Followers of Christ".

---

### **CBI 103 - Getting To Know Jesus**

**6 hours**

Who is Jesus? Join us as we examine the gospel of John. We will look at His miracles and teachings to discover the overwhelming evidence that He is who He say He is - the Son of God! He gives life and is victorious over death. He fills our deepest needs. He guides and provides. He corrects and protects. He is the one we have been looking for!

### **CBI 104 - Developing Biblical Foundations for Life**

**12 hours**

Behind every self-defeating behavior is a self-deceiving lie we've been telling ourselves. It's called our worldview. Our worldview is the set of beliefs about ourselves, the world around us and God that defines our attitudes and actions in life. Since choices always have consequences, it is vital that we build our own personal worldview on the truth of God's Word. This course is designed to walk students through the twelve essential topics that become the foundation for a Biblical worldview. Our Biblical worldview becomes our foundation for life.

### **CBI 105 - Living in Community**

**6 hours**

The Sermon on the Mount is both deep and wide. These three chapters (Matthew 5 – 7) deal with finding happiness in every circumstance, impacting our world for Jesus, two ways to approach God, keys to healthy relationships and common forms of spiritual deception. Detailed issues include humility, anger, lust, honesty, forgiveness, and anxiety about financial matters. Jesus gives us victory in all of these real life issues!

## **SCHOOL OF GROWTH**

### **CBI 201 - Worship as a Lifestyle**

**6 hours**

A common misconception, even among seasoned Christians, is that worship is about singing. There is even a style of music that has been dubbed “worship” music. Singing can help us enter into an attitude of worship, but worship is a lifestyle of wholeheartedly giving ourselves to honoring the God who made us. God is not just looking for believers; He is looking for true worshipers. This course describes what that lifestyle looks like and challenges us all to be worshippers, not just while singing, but every day and everywhere!

### **CBI 202 - How to Study the Bible**

**12 hours**

The Bible teaches us that you can't truly be a disciple of Jesus Christ if you do not have a regular intake of His Word. This course is a “how to” course on Bible Study. It assumes that you already know the importance of personal Bible study and that you are seeking how to accomplish it. Each study method is presented in such a way that any believer in Jesus can follow steps and be able on his or her own to really gain something out of the study. This course will also introduce the use of basic reference tools which aid in Bible study.

---

### **CBI 203 - The Role of the Holy Spirit in Your Life**

**6 hours**

Come explore what the Bible says about the ministry of the Holy Spirit! We begin by looking at the role of the Holy Spirit in the Old Testament, starting with creation, through the history of Israel, and to the Prophets of the Old Testament. We will then move to the role of the Holy Spirit in the birth, life and ministry of Jesus. Finally, we will address modern day issues regarding the Holy Spirit such as His role in the life of the believer and the gifts He presents to us to serve others.

### **CBI 204 - Sharing My Faith**

**6 hours**

How hard is it to share your faith in Jesus Christ with family or friends or co-workers? Have you wished you could talk to others about how Jesus changed your life? This course is a very practical approach at sharing your faith. In the course you will discover different styles of evangelism and learn to write and share your faith in a very simple format.

## **CBI 205 - Old Testament Survey**

**12 hours**

The Old Testament consists of 39 books that contain the history of the nation of Israel, the laws of God for Israel, inspiring poetry, and the messages of numerous prophets. To understand how these books relate to one another, we will emphasize the “foundational books” which provide the historical basis of the Old Testament in Part 1 of this course. Once we work our way through the foundational books, the other Old Testament books will be linked to this historical base in Part 2. We will also emphasize God’s covenant promises to Abraham and his descendants. Our understanding of the Old Testament context will help us understand the covenant relationship with God that is available to us through the death of Jesus Christ.

## **CBI 206 - New Testament Survey**

**12 hours**

The New Testament is worthy of a lifetime of study, as it answers the most significant questions people have asked. What is the purpose of life? Is there any real hope? What is God like? Can I be freed from guilt and sin? Jesus Christ is the only answer to those questions. He is the key to God’s New Covenant, the central theme of the New Testament. In order to fully appreciate the New Covenant, you must explore the life and times of Christ and the other New Testament writers. New Testament Survey organizes this essential information around the anticipation, institution, and fulfillment of the New Covenant. This book-by-book study, which will be taught in two six week sessions, includes a look at political forces and ideologies of the first century Roman world. New Testament Survey is designed to give you a rich understanding of God’s precious New Covenant as presented in the New Testament. Indeed, this is a study worthy of your time and energy.

---

## **CBI 207 – Prayer For Life**

**12 hours**

Prayer for Life is a study designed to help the new Christian learn how to pray and the seasoned Christian to deepen their prayer life. Beginning with the basics, what prayer is and how to pray, the believer at all maturity levels will develop their prayer life thus developing their relationship with God. The course will cover all aspects of prayer in 12 steps, consisting of 12 lessons, designed to enrich your time with the Lord.

## **SCHOOL OF SERVICE**

### **CBI 301 - Finding My NICHE**

**6 hours**

This course aims first to help you understand and find the elements of your NICHE – your Natural abilities, your Individuality, your Charisma, your Heart, and your Experience. Then we will help you to develop that knowledge into an act of personal transformation for God’s glory.

### **CBI 302 - Mentoring 101**

**6 hours**

God wants us to help one another all the way. The goal of this course is “To help individuals reach their full potential of becoming a Fully Developed Follower of Christ through personal development.” It examines the history of spiritual mentoring, mentoring necessity, unique women and men mentoring attributes, finding a mentor or protégé, toxic mentoring, and common mentoring questions.

### **CBI 305 - Ephesians**

**6 hours**

The course on Ephesians is designed to open your eyes to the riches and responsibilities of being a Christ-follower. Ephesians is one of the shortest books in the New Testament but it is full of wisdom for us and for our families. Come and learn to live in the blessings and resources available to us!

## **SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP**

### **CBI 402 - Romans**

**6 hours**

Romans will help you to develop a greater understanding of “the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God” (Romans 11:33), to strengthen your faith and understanding of God's righteousness and the Gospel, and to reach an in depth understanding of the doctrine of salvation and sanctification. The course will be presented in a seminar format with limited enrollment.

**CBI 404 - Developing Leaders**

Developing and maintaining leadership skills is vital for success in today's world. This course explores basic leadership skills that will enhance any role in God's Kingdom. This is a six session course that will encourage the participants to step up to the plate and begin to use their God given talents and abilities to lead those around them.
